Historical/Biographical Notes

The collection provides a pictorial representation of parades held in Lincoln on the fourth of July during the 20th century. In addition to the patriotic aspect of the parades, various floats and groups depict important local issues of the time.

Scope and Content

The collection comprises primarily photographs taken of July 4th parades and events in Lincoln from 1910. Expensive photographs of the 1976 parade and celebration were taken by local photographer Ted Polumbaum, and a set of mounted photographs of the 1982 July 4th parade and celebration were taken by local photographer Dianna Rust.

The collection arranged chronologically.

Series 1: pre-1960. Snapshots from 1910 and 1924. (3 items)

Series 2: 1960-1969. Snapshots primarily of the 4H Club. (11 items)

Series 3: 1970-1975. Floats and marchers. (8 items)
