#### **Collection Information**

<u>Abstract</u>: Baseball in Lincoln started in 1873 with the establishment of the Forest Lake team, later the Lincolns, and then Lincoln Mohawks in 1929. Interest waned in the 1950s, and the focus was directed toward youth baseball.

#### **Historical/Biographical Notes**

Baseball was established in Lincoln with the organization of the Forest Lake team, so called after a local name for Flint's Pond. The team, later known as the Lincolns, played with teams from surrounding and nearby towns. Other informal baseball teams formed by 1900. In 1902 baseball in Lincoln was formalized by the founding of the Lincoln Town Team, which played in the newly formed Old Colony League until World War I. Following the war, the team was reestablished as a semi-professional team, which played until 1931. The Lincoln Mohawks were organized in 1929 as an amateur team, playing in the Paul Revere League. In 1939 they joined the semi-professional Boston Suburban League, and had a successful record with teams from area towns. The Mohawks were the local champions from 1947 until 1950. Interest in adult baseball waned in the 1950s, and the focus of baseball became youth oriented, with establishment of school and Little League teams.

#### **Scope and Content**

The collection comprises historical notes relating to the Lincoln baseball teams, lists of players, statistics, photographs, correspondence, clippings, and ephemera. Bulk of the collection relates to the Lincoln Mohawks baseball team, active from 1929 into the 1950s. Also includes letters written by Mohawks players in the military services during World War II.

The collection is arranged topically.
