Abstract : Genealogy of the John and Elizabeth Baker family of Killingly, Connecticut, and allied families, from ca. 1690 to ca. 1980; emphasizing the Baker family branches that settled in the Lincoln-Concord area.

### **Historical/Biographical Notes**

The Baker family emigrated from England in 1720 and settled initially in Killingly, Connecticut. Throughout the 1700s family members dispersed to all parts of New England. Some time prior to 1775, members of the family were living in western part of Lincoln. Members of the Baker family were among the earliest of Lincoln residents, and were active during the Revolutionary War. Descendants of the original Bakers are still resident in Lincoln.

### **Scope and Content**

The collection comprises an excerpt from the second edition of the Baker family genealogy, *Like ghosts at cockcrow*, written in 2001 by David F. Baker of Salisbury, Maryland. The excerpt includes genealogical information on the first ten generations of the family, and the excerpt emphasizes the Bakers in the Lincoln, Massachusetts area.
