Historical/Biographical Notes

The Hartwell family settled in Concord in the 1630s from England. William Hartwell over time became one of the principal property owners in the part of Concord that was in 1754 set off to become Lincoln. The farmstead dates to the late 17th century, although many changes and alterations were made to the property over 300 years. Hartwell farm burnt in 1968. The land, now a part of Minute Man National Historic Park, has had archaeological excavations carried out under the National Park Service, and the ruins of the house, primarily brick and stone work, have been stabilized.

Scope and Content

The Samuel Hartwell Farmstead, a 16 p. manuscript with plans, photographs, maps, photocopies of deeds, and bibliography, was written in 1985 by Gulli Kula, Harvard University, as part of the course requirements for Anthropology under Professor Stephen Williams.
