## **Historical/Biographical Notes**

Present day Lincoln was incorporated as a Town in 1754, eight years after the area was set off as the Second Precinct of Lexington, Weston, and Concord, the three Towns which ceded land to the new Town of Lincoln. The three parent towns were parts of royal land grants in the 1630s and 1640s, and the area was settled before the middle of the 17th century, including the land that Lincoln now occupies. The oldest extant buildings in Lincoln date to the middle 17th century.

The original settlers in the area were primarily farmers. Although the land had been glaciated, soils are relatively thick and of good quality. Agriculture remains an important part of Lincoln today, although the town is predominately a bedroom community.

Development of photography in the 1840s, and particularly the development of albumen printing processes in the 1850s and 1860s, created an intense interest in the new science, and during the last half of the 19th century, probably most buildings in Lincoln had been photographed, both by itinerant photographers and by local or regional people.

Documentation of the buildings in Lincoln exist in many published works and unpublished papers. The Lincoln Historical Society compiled information on the historical buildings in Lincoln in the 1960s. This information was reviewed and standardized in the late 1970s by the Lincoln Historical Commission, and remains the best source for documentation of historical buildings. Photographs of all historical buildings were taken as part of the Commission's project.

## **Scope and Content**

The collection comprises over 500 photographs, and over 200 pieces of documentation of Lincoln buildings. Included with the collection are aerial photographs, street scenes, miscellaneous structures and views, and other items found with the photographs and documentation. Provenance is from many sources, as well as unknown. The collection includes both items donated to the Lincoln Public Library and to the Lincoln Historical Society, as well as materials compiled by the Lincoln Historical Commission. As far as is known, original order has been retained.

The collection is arranged topically into four series, and is mostly described to item level.
