Historical/Biographical Notes

A petition to the Governor and General Court in 1746 from the inhabitants of the easterly part of Concord, the westerly part of Lexington, and the northerly part of Weston requested to be set off from their respective towns in order to have a more convenient location for worship. A precinct was established, which gave the inhabitants authority to build a meeting house and hire a minister, the Second Precinct of Concord, Lexington, and Weston. A subsequent petition led to the incorporation of the Town of Lincoln in 1754, encompassing approximately the area formerly the Second Precinct. Evolution of Town government over 250 years has increased the number and kind of municipal services provided by Towns in Massachusetts. The first townwide school committee was elected in 1808, although the following year no committee was elected and governance of schools reverted to School District Committees. Beginning in 1815 town-wide school committees were regularly elected. Beginning in 1820 the Town appropriated money to each school district, to be spent at the discretion of the voters within the school district, who also chose teachers, arranged for repairs, supplies, and other matters. Prior to this, the Selectmen had managed school affairs. The School Committee in the 19th century was largely concerned with hiring teachers for winter term, overseeing classroom progress, and exercised some control over curriculum and other matters. High school students were sent to adjacent towns for their education until 1954, when the Lincoln-Sudbury Regional High School Committee was formed and the regional high school opened. The former district schools were in use into the 1940s and 1950s. In 1949 Smith School, the first school of what would become a public school campus of elementary through middle school grades was opened. Hartwell School was opened in 1960, and Joseph Brooks School in 1964. Schools at the Hanscom Field Air Force base also are administered by the Town of Lincoln.

Scope and Content

The collection comprises minutes of meetings of the Lincoln and the Lincoln-Sudbury School Committees, education reports, newsletters, clippings, materials relating to building construction and expansion, financial records, and other records of schools in Lincoln ca. 1940s-2000; also includes materials on Liberal School, Lincoln High School, District School Committee records, building needs, and other records ca. 1800s-1930s; also includes materials relating to private schools in Lincoln and adjoining towns.
