## **Historical/Biographical Notes**

Photography as a medium was developed in Europe in the 1840s with the daguerreotype, introduced into United States around 1849. Daguerreotypes were quickly replaced by ambrotypes and tintypes, but by around 1860 development of albumen prints allowed reproducible photographs with negatives. The earlier photographs were unique items, and could not be copied until later development of equipment to photograph and make copy prints of the early photographs. Improvements in photographic processes led through the development of collodion prints, cyanotypes, and others. By around 1900 silver gelatin prints were dominant, and remain so today in an improved form. Most early photographs were mounted on stiff paper or cardboard in a variety of formats, as early prints tended to roll up without additional support. By the 1900s also, photography became a home hobby, as cameras and processing equipment was simplified over the heavy and awkward tools of early photographers. Film improvements reduced exposure times from several seconds to small fractions of seconds, and home photography became universal.

## **Scope and Content**

The collection comprises miscellaneous photographs of local people and groups, events, street scenes, views, etc., taken between ca. 1870s to the 1970s in a variety of processes and formats. Nineteenth century railroad photographs, and snapshots of a 1992 Patriots Day celebration are among the collection highlights, as well as other group photographs, photographic copies of militia commissions of Eleazer Brooks, and scenes of Lincoln at various times. The collection content is about 1 linear foot.
