Collection Information

<u>Abstract</u>: The Preston Papers are a collection of primary and secondary source materials relating to miscellaneous Lincoln people, organizations, and events, dating from the 1940s to the 1980s, and collected by Jean Preston of Lincoln.

Historical/Biographical Notes

Jean Preston was born in 1908, and was married to the late William Preston, a physicist who was involved in World War II era programs at Oak Ridge, Tennessee. She was active in the League of Women Voters of Lincoln and other organizations. Jean Preston died in January 1980.

Scope and Content

The collection comprises primary and secondary source materials relating to the Town of Lincoln, Lincoln people, events, organizations, from ca. 1940s to ca. 1980s, collected by Jean (Mrs. William) Preston of Lincoln. Of particular interest are papers relating to the establishment of the Codman Community Farms, Inc., and civilian relief activities by Lincoln women during World War II. The papers were organized topically in 1990 by members of the Lincoln Historical Society.
